
Paranoid Androids On Steroids

The Game

We compete in the First Tech Challenge, an international robotics competition, with a chapter in NYC. Each year, there are new tasks for our robots to complete meaning that each season we need to design, build, and code an entirely new robot. We also do community outreach as part of our team's mission to spread STEM to others. This includes STEM activity sessions for kids, mentoring other teams, and teaching sponsors about FIRST.


